Artistic Residency in France

for young talented musicians from Louisiana

About the Grant

Every year the Club France-Louisiane awards **three grants** to young talented musicians from Louisiana. Every year the grants are addressed to musicians of a different city among the three main cities of Louisiana: New Orleans, Lafayette and Baton Rouge.

The grants 2014/2015 are addressed to Lafayette's musicians.

The winners will be granted an **artistic residency in Grenoble (France)** in the first trimester of the year n+1.

The artistic residency will be on the new music-dance style called Bikutsi-Jazz, and it will be concluded by performances and/or cd recording.

The duration of the artistic residency will be between two and three weeks. Program and dates of the artistic residency will be fixed by the Club France-Louisiane and cannot be modified.

The program shall include interventions in academies and schools, as well as shows, for advertising the culture and music of Louisiana in France.

The Club France-Louisiane will cover transport and accommodation fees for the winners. It will take care of all the logistic organization, from the flight booking to the accommodation and transport in France. The winners will be welcomed and guided by members of the Club France-Louisiane.

An attendance certificate will be given to the winners at the end of the artistic residency and they will be worldwide promote by the Club France-Louisiane as participants to the Bikutsi-Jazz project.

Eligibility

Open to all young musicians between 18 and 25, mastering one of the following instruments or abilities:

- Sax
- Trumpet
- Zideko
- Choir director and piano-keyboard player

Knowledge of French will be considered an asset.

Deadline

Monday 3th of November 2014, by 5pm (local time)

Selection procedure

A pre-selection will be based on the curriculum vitae and the record sent by the applicants.

The selected candidates will be noticed to arrange a video-interview by Skype, during which they will have 5 minutes to show at the best their skill with their instrument.

The winners will receive in due time the detailed program of the artistic residency.
